to parents/guardians for attending our Meet the Teacher night on September 14th. It was a pleasure meeting with all of you!

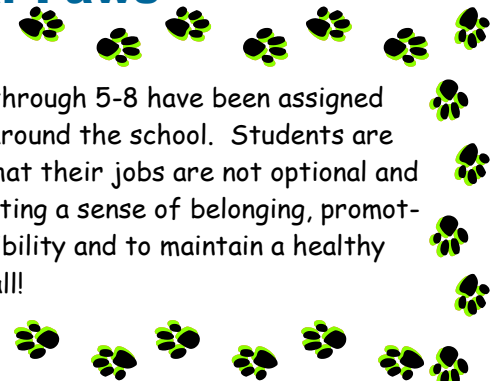
***A message for Grade 8 Students who leave the school grounds on their lunch break:***
